

HULARO®

Used in the *Sienna* collection, Hularo® is a polyethylene based, extruded and vat-dyed synthetic fiber, manufactured in Germany. The material is molded into strips which is then hand-woven onto the frame (a day's work is required for one armchair.) It is much easier to clean and is longer lasting than natural fibers such as wicker or rattan. It is durable, tear-proof and highly resistant to UV rays (material is colorfast to 4.5*), chlorine & salt water, lotions, microorganisms, and stains from food or drink, including alcohol.

Colors available: Dark Sienna.

Tones in the Hularo® weave may slightly vary from each piece, to create added definition and character to the furniture. Hularo® is a recyclable, toxin-free resin. Please contact your local recycling program to find out where this material is accepted.

We recommend the use of Hularo® furniture only between -30°C (-22°F) to 65°C (149°F) surface temperature. However, polyethylene, the base material of Hularo®, is cold-resistant down to -50°C (-58°F) and heat-resistant up to 90°C (194°F). At this cold extreme, Hularo® becomes very hard (and breakable!) like glass. At the heat extreme, Hularo® can melt under any weight or

pressure. However, the fiber will come back to its initial shape once removed from the heat. Note: Direct contact against heat lamps, lights, or other heat sources should be avoided. Please see allowable temperature ranges below on "Glass Tops" if you plan to use a glass top with your *Sienna* table.

The *Sienna* collection should not be used in high wind regions. The material is lightweight – an added benefit for clients to move the furniture around, but problematic for clients who experience a lot of wind in their area. The furniture should be protected or stored in the event of unusually high wind or storm advisories.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

To clean, simply wipe down or hose lightly using fresh water. Use a natural-based soap with a sponge or soft brush. We recommend washing furniture on at least a yearly basis. Do not clean using any type of abrasive agent or scouring pad, as scratches can remain on the surface.

If scratches develop, the best way to remove them is by blowing hot air from a hair dryer on the affected spot to soften the material, and then smooth out the material using a soft cloth.

WARRANTY

We warrant Hularo® based product in the *Sienna* Collection sold to the original owner to be free from defects in material and construction for 2 years of normal residential use. This warranty does not apply to damage resulting from improper maintenance, misuse, negligence, or normal wear.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Glass table tops for *Sienna* tables:

Tempered (3/8" thick) glass table tops are optional for use in the *Sienna* collection. *Sienna* glass tops are not recommended for regions that have temperatures of 105°F (40°C) or higher. The glass tops can potentially create a "lens effect" in sunlight, which can soften and temporarily ripple the Hularo® weave below the glass. It is not advised that glass tops be left outdoors during snowy weather, as the weight of the snow may crack or break the top. We do not offer a warranty on our glass tops.

***Sienna* frames / feet:**

The frames are made of aluminum, welded by hand, then are oven-baked with an epoxy powder-coating. The feet are also made of aluminum.
