

# UMBRELLAS & BASES

Umbrella covers are constructed with the same high-quality Dralon® acrylic canvas as our cushion fabric, although in a heavier awning weight to provide exceptional coverage. Dralon® is fiber-dyed, meaning that it is first spun and twisted, then colored. The material is also treated with Teflon® to provide water and stain resistance. The eucalyptus wood pole and ribs, lacquered in a teak color, are supported by brass hardware for superior strength and easy maintenance. In addition to the durability of the construction, our umbrellas employ a pulley system to easily lift and lower the umbrella. A solid brass pin secures the opened umbrella in place – two height positions are available.

Our umbrella covers are pre-fabricated. We do not offer custom-made umbrella covers.

Henry Hall Designs' umbrella stands are heavy weight for the utmost in umbrella security. Our umbrella stands currently available are the BR31 and the BY35 stands – see pricelist for complete product details. In coastal areas, we recommend that the BY35 stand is used.

Our umbrellas and umbrella bases can be used in conjunction with selected tables, or can be used for freestanding use:

## For freestanding use:

Any combination of umbrella can be used with any combination of umbrella base.

## For use of table with umbrella hole:

~ 01060 or 01061 Eclipse Round tables: use UW315 10' Octagonal with BR31 base (base cannot exceed 25" diameter) and D8203 Stainless Steel table holder insert.

~ E1080 Eclipse Round coffee table: umbrella is not recommended in windy areas. If used, use an umbrella not larger than 8' (not currently offered by Henry Hall) with BR31 base (base cannot exceed 25" diameter) and D8203 Stainless Steel table holder insert.

~ LEY280 \* Oval table: use UW315 10' Octagonal with BY35 base and PLGM teak table holder insert.

~ LEY180 \* Round table: use UW315 10' Octagonal with CEYT65T Table support tube and PLGM teak table holder insert.

~ MA120 or MA 140 Mariposa Round Pedestal tables: No standard available. Base cannot exceed 21" diameter. Use PLGM teak table holder insert.

\* tables ONLY have umbrella hole exposed when in extended position.

## REGULAR CARE

Our covers are made with top vents to protect from gusts of wind. However, it is important that umbrellas should be kept closed when not in use, in the event of sudden wind storms. In the case of severe weather, umbrellas should be removed from the table and kept indoors in their breathable, protective storage bags. To prolong the life of your umbrella, we recommend taking it indoors when not in use – this will prolongs the new look of the umbrella as it avoids excessive exposure to UV ray damage, bird droppings, etc.

It is also a good idea to occasionally wax the umbrella pole – this will aid in the smooth

movement of the umbrella. Also, occasionally wax the finial – it can be unscrewed from the top of the pole. The finial gets a lot of weather exposure and under time may develop cracks due to drying out. Henry Hall Designs recommends a natural beeswax product such as "Howard Feed N' Wax", although be attentive when oils are present to make sure extra residue is wiped off, and does not stain fabrics, etc.

## CLEANING

To prolong the new look of your fabrics, we recommended that you regularly (once every 1-2 months) brush off dirt to prevent it from settling deep in the fabric. Outdoor fabrics do not promote mildew growth; however, mildew may grow on dirt and other deposits on the fabric. Spray down the umbrella at a high hose pressure to rinse of these deposits and let it air out to dry.

## Deep cleaning:

Remove the cover from the umbrella frame and scrub off dirt using a soft bristle brush with fresh water mixed a small amount of natural soap (such a laundry detergent.) Do not soak thoroughly, just enough to get the surface dirt off. Let it air out to dry.

If mildew does build on the fabric – or other deep stains – prepare a mild solution of one cup bleach plus two caps full of a natural soap per gallon of water and allow to soak in the affected areas. Scrub with a soft bristle brush. Rinse with fresh water. Allow to air dry – do not put covers in the dryer.

Alternatively, umbrella covers can be dry cleaned. However, we do not recommend putting umbrella covers in the washing machine.

## WARRANTY

We warrant our umbrella frames, umbrella fabrics and umbrella stands sold to the original owner, to be free from defects in material and construction for 1 year of normal residential use. This warranty does not apply to damage from misuse or leaving umbrellas open in severe weather conditions or other damage resulting from improper maintenance, misuse, negligence, or normal wear and tear.
